### What is GDPR?

General Data Protection Regulation came into effect on May 25th, 2018 and it helps us to keep information about you and your child safe.

#### HOW YOUR INFORMATION IS USED

We are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. We must collect information (data) about you and your child to enable us to understand and assess your individual needs and preferences and to assist us to provide the full range of services you require.

We apply the following principles when dealing with you and your child's Personal Data:

- Personal data will be processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner
- Personal data will only be used in the manner for which it was provided
- Personal data is relevant, adequate, limited and stored safely
- Personal data is accurate and up to date and not stored for longer than is necessary



#### Your Rights

GDPR sets out the following rights applicable to you as a Data Subject:

- The right to be informed
- The right of access
- The right to rectification
- The right to erasure\*
- The right to restrict processing\*
- The right to data portability\*
- The right to object\*
