

WHY SHOULD MY CHILD BE REFERRED TO THE PCT?

The PCT offers:

- Expert clinical assessment and management of complex symptoms.
- Support when faced with difficult decisions and treatment choices.
- Help deciding where you and your child feels is the best place to receive the care needed. This could be at home, in a hospital local to your home or here in Children's Health Ireland at Crumlin.
- Access to telephone support Monday to Friday.
- Information about local services and support organisations and help in coordinating these services.

Every child and family is different, and the team provides a variety of types of support depending on your needs. The type of support you and your child may need is likely to vary throughout your child's illness. Our involvement in your child's care may be for a few short weeks or for many years.

HOW CAN MY CHILD BE REFERRED TO THE PCT?

Your child's primary consultant can make a referral to the Palliative Care Team. You will be aware of this referral.



WHAT WE DO

Palliative care aims to achieve the best quality of life possible for children and their families living with a life-threatening or life shortening illness.

The Palliative Care (PCT) service at Children's Health Ireland at Crumlin, cares for children and their families from diagnosis or recognition of this type of illness.

We can support you and your child throughout the illness, alongside disease specific treatments.

We work with other teams within Children's Health Ireland at Crumlin, other hospitals, community homecare teams and voluntary services to ensure your child receives the coordinated care they need for their condition. The primary team remains the lead team in caring for your child.
